FREELANDER “DISTRICT ONE” CHARDONNAY – CALIFORNIA

The inaugural Chardonnay release from Frelander. This California wine shows good acidity providing a nice balance to the ripe pineapple, pear, and passion fruit flavors; a hint of vanilla spice oak adds an extra layer of complexity providing a gentle well-balanced finish.

BODEGAS BILBAO VALINAS ALBARINO – SPAIN

Straw-yellow in color with bright emphasis reminiscent of Granny Smith apples. On the nose, fresh aromas and a salty touch mingles with nuances of apricot and peach. The palate is elegant, fresh, harmonious in perfect balance with the sweet sensations left by the fruit flavors. Smooth and supple, great for Spring.

CROWDED HOUSE SAUVIGNON BLANC – NEW ZEALAND

Showing a pale straw color in the glass and offering lots of peach and honeysuckle on the nose, the wine enters the palate with bold flavors of tropical fruit and minerality. As it warms up, flavors of dried herbs and Meyer lemons begin to shine through. Refreshingly full of New Zealand personality.

PONGA SAUVIGNON BLANC – NEW ZEALAND

Ponga is a bold, expressive New Zealand S. Blanc that shines through in the world of Sauvignon. Pale straw in appearance with vibrant aromas of ripe citrus and tropical fruits lead into a refreshing palate full of white peach and grapefruit. The crisp and clean aromas are accentuated with chalky, mineral tones.

MANISCALCO PINOT GRIGIO – ITALY

A refreshing and crisp Pinot with hints of apples and fresh white flowers aromas that introduce the palate to pronounced citrus fruits and impressive minerality, this is a Pinot Grigio that slowly evolves showing complexity while retaining a crisp acidity.

M. CHAPOUTIER MARIUS BLANC – FRANCE

This wine carries the warmth of the soil in the South of France where this wine is rooted. A blend of Terret and Vermentino grapes, Terret adding vivacity to the Vermentino with its elegant floral aromas. On the palate we find citrus aromas and notes of grapefruit and ripe fruit, this delicious white is ample, rich, revealing lovely acidity and complexity.

TORTOISE CREEK PINOT NOIR – CALIFORNIA

This wine has great varietal character in the aroma and follows through with tempting spice, red fruit and savory nuances on the palate. Black tea, red cherry and clove waft from the glass while cherry and cranberry spread across the palate, braced by moderate tannins and fresh acidity. It's a beautifully balanced medium-bodied Pinot.

SOKOL BLOSSER “EVOLUTION” PINOT NOIR – OREGON

Complexity and fruit come together in a very special way for this Pinot; dangerously juicy and fruit driven with a sophisticated silky mid-palate displaying hints of pomegranate, cherry and baking spices. Focused and tangy on the finish tracing a delicate line of minerality reminiscent of a Cru Beaujolais.

SANTA JULIA MOUNTAIN RESERVA RED BLEND – ARGENTINA

A blend of Malbec and Cabernet Franc from old vines planted at very high elevation provide an astonishing terroir that stand out for their concentration of aromas and flavors; full-bodied wine with red plum, dark fruit, spice and coffee notes wrapped up this smooth, textured and velvety blend. You are going to love this combination of grapes.

FIDELITY CRAZY CREEK MERITAGE – CALIFORNIA

This popular blend shows how Zinfandel and Petite Sirah complement each other perfectly: Zinfandel offers robust blackberry, anise and pepper aromas and flavors. Petite Sirah brings blueberry, plummy fruit with roundness and structure to the mid-palate. The Zinfandel returns adding grace, length and elegance. Light-handed oak aging influences the Petite Sirah to add a chocolate note in the finish.

LA MOZZA “I PERAZZI” CABERNET SAUVIGNON – ITALY

A knockout first vintage of this Cabernet from the La Mozza estate expressing the terroir of the Maremma region of Tuscany; clean, intense aromas of mature wild blackberry and cassis, with a backdrop of sweet caressing spices, vanilla, cinnamon, and a light shade of pepperiness emerge after some time in the glass. Medium-full on the palate, nicely round and substantial showing velvety tannins on the finish that give the wine elegance and length.

GERBERAS GRENACHE – SPAIN

The Grenache wines from Aragon are characterized by their balance, their crisp fruit flavors and their energy and personality; Gerberas Grenache is made from 30 years old vines expressing the heritage of Aragon with its intense purple reflections, a bouquet of ripe fruit laced with some floral notes and spices, juicy and delicious.

CANOE RIDGE “THE EXPEDITION” CABERNET SAUVIGNON – WA

Beautiful aromas of Marion berry and blackberry cobbler pick up attractive hints of vanilla, cocoa powder and rose petal. Its tannin structure is reminiscent of a perfect date – arriving early and staying late – within a fruit structure of currant and cranberries. There’s some lusciousness on the midpalate that carries into a chocolaty finish.
